Why Consider the Foundation?

The Barry Community Foundation bridges the dreams and desires of donors with the needs of the community. A community foundation differs from a private foundation, as the assets are not the gift of a single family, individual or corporation. A pool of funds, contributed by a number of donors, for a wide range of charitable purposes, creates the assets.

Because of this, the community foundation is the perfect vehicle for all kinds of donors – individuals, families, corporations, private foundations, and nonprofit organization. The Barry Community Foundation has the ability to establish funds that meet many different charitable objectives. The foundation has an extensive gift acceptance policy, guiding the board and staff on how and what type of gifts can be accepted. For a copy of the policy, simply call the office at 945-0526.

The beauty of humanity is that no two persons are the same; similarly, no two funds in our foundation are the same. Each fund bears its own name, making it the perfect memorial or honorarium opportunity. Chosen by the donor, the fund may be established in the name of a loved one, a corporation, or family. Funds may even be established anonymously.

To meet the needs of our donor's dreams and desires, the following types of funds are offered:

Unrestricted Funds – An unrestricted fund would be your choice if you were concerned about community needs. This type of fund enables the granting committee of the Barry Community Foundation to award a broad range of charitable grants, based on the ever-changing needs of Barry County.

Field of Interest Funds – If education, The Arts, youth recreation, conservation or a specific region of Barry County is your area of interest and concern, this type of fund will help you meet your objectives.

Donor Advised Funds – This fund allows you to play a very active role in determining this distribution of grants, reviewing and making recommendations to the Board regarding what projects and organizations should be funded. These funds are an excellent choice for individuals or

corporations who have considered a private foundation, but want to avoid excise taxes, payout requirements and administrative responsibilities. Funds are contributed and may or may not be endowed.

Designated Fund – If you have a desire to create long-term stability for one or more particular nonprofit organizations, a designated fund is the vehicle for you. With a permanent endowment fund established in their name, the organization enjoys income forever, while you assist them in carrying out their mission.

Scholarship Funds – Your scholarship fund can provide several different opportunities for Barry County residents. You may award a scholarship for attendance to a specific school, to support a particular course of study or to assist a particular high school.

Animal Advocacy

The Barry County Humane Society Animal Awareness Trust of Barry County- *This fund's purpose is to protect and preserve "His creatures of this earth," as determined from time to time by an advisory committee and approved by the Foundation. The fund may also be used for, but is not limited to, education, in the broadest sense of the term, relating to animals.*

The Arts

Donald and Catherine Williamson Visual and Performing Arts Scholarship Fund – *This fund was created for the purpose of supporting young people in the study of visual and performing arts. The fund's advisors are Donald and Catherine Williamson and, following their deaths, Melinda Cutlip, Donald G. Williamson, Stacie Willshire and Kenneth Williamson.*

Louise Ann Stockham Memorial Fund – *This fund makes dollars available for the purchase of an art collection for display by Barry County non-profits. This fund will also accept art pieces for the same purpose.*

Sue Drummond Art Education Fund of the Thornapple Arts Council – *The purpose of this fund is to expose children of Barry County to the arts, defined to include visual, music, fiber, literature, and performing arts. Exposure includes participating, as well as listening or watching. No more than one half of the funds are to be used for scholarships, and no more than one-quarter are to be used for countywide youth projects.*

Thornapple Players Club Fund – *This fund is used to support the charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes of the Thornapple Players, as determined from time to time by the BCF board of directors. The mission of the Thornapple Players Club is to provide an outlet for creative involvement and quality theater entertainment for our community.*

Community

Angel Fund – *The purpose of this fund is to support charitable programs, projects, and scholarships in Barry County.*

Barry Community Foundation Community Wide Grantmaking Fund – *This fund supports the charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes created by and for the people of Barry County.*

Barry Community Foundation Management Endowment Fund – *This fund provides operating dollars for the administration of the Barry Community Foundation.*

Barry County Healthy Youth and Seniors' Fund – *This fund was established to promote health and prevent health crises for the young and for senior adults in Barry County.*

Barry County United Way Fund – *This fund supports the scientific, educational, and community projects of the Barry County United Way. The Barry County United Way's mission is to improve lives by mobilizing the caring power of Barry County communities.*

Barry County Victim Services Unit – *The fund is to be used for the support of the charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes of Barry County Victim Services Unit. The Barry County Victim Services Unit is a group of volunteers dedicated to helping victims survive crises or crimes against them. They are the helping hands for the police, fire, and medical personnel, freeing emergency personnel to do their jobs without leaving the victim feeling forgotten, excluded or ignored.*

Community Involvement Fund – *This fund was established to support projects that build community and strengthen the capacity of organizations working together.*

Carl Grashuis Family Fund – *This fund, for which the advisors are the children and grandchildren of Mr. Grashuis, was created to support charitable activities within Barry County.*

Delton Area Business Fund – *This fund is for the benefit of the Delton area for charitable programs and projects, including, but not limited to, economic development.*

Florence Tyden Groos Memorial Fund for the Barry County United Way-
This fund supports Barry County United Way's administrative expenses.

Harold Hawks Memorial Fund – *The purpose of this fund is to support charitable activities in Barry County.*

Hastings Area Rotary Club Fund– *This fund shall be used exclusively to supplement the programs of the Rotary Club of Hastings, Michigan, and/or its members as determined from time to time by the club's board of directors.*

Hastings Country Club Charity Golf Classic – *This fund supports the charitable golf tournament of the Hastings Country Club. The fund is used to grant money to the selected charities benefited by the outing.*

Hastings Elks Lodge 1965 Charitable Fund – *The fund supports the charitable grantmaking programs of the Hastings Elks Lodge.*

Hastings Junior Chamber of Commerce Fund – *This fund is for the purpose of providing leadership through community service for people between the ages of 21 and 40. The funds are for the use of the Hastings Junior Chamber of Commerce.*

Kiwanis Club of Hastings Fund – *This fund was established to benefit the charitable activities of the Kiwanis Club of Hastings.*

Leadership Barry County Fund – *This fund supports the charitable, scientific, literary, and/or educational purposes of Leadership Barry County. Leadership Barry County is designed to enhance leadership skills for individual growth, organizational improvement and increased community effectiveness.*

Next Generation Fund – *This fund is used to provide charitable support to Barry County, as recommended by the advisory committee of this fund. The fund’s members consist of community residents from the ages of “twenty-something” to “forty-something.” The goal of the Next Generation Fund is to provide convenient, family-minded opportunities for philanthropy among the “Next Generation.”*

Pennock Health Services Fund – *This fund was established to support the betterment of Pennock Health Services Organization.*

Project Team Up Events Fund – *This fund is used to support regional activities of Project Team Up. Project Team Up is the partnership of community foundations serving Southwest Michigan.*

Richard T. and Ethel D. Groos Memorial Fund – *This fund was established for the purpose of gifting memorial contributions to the Barry Community Foundation’s Barry Community Grantmaking Fund.*

Roger Milo Shaw Memorial Fund to benefit St. Rose School - *The distribution of income, subject to an appropriate spending rule, will support the educational purposes of St. Rose of Lima in Hastings.*

Sand Ridge Bank Community Fund – *This is a non-endowed fund that supports 501(c) (3) programs, projects, and organizations that serve Barry County. Sand Ridge employees review requests and present recommendations for community grants to the Barry Community Foundation board.*

Thornapple Area Enrichment Foundation Fund – *This fund was established to support the Thornapple Area Enrichment Foundation for charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes, for and in the Thornapple area.*

Thornapple Foundation Gift Fund – *This fund provides grants for special projects of the Barry Community Foundation, as advised by the donor and approved by the Barry Community Foundation board of directors.*

Vida Blood Memorial Fund for the First Presbyterian Church of Hastings – *This fund's income is to be used for supporting the purposes of the First Presbyterian Church of Hastings, with the advice and consent of the fund's advisory committee.*

Volunteer Center of Barry County, Barry County United Way- George Romney Fund – *The purpose of this fund is to support the charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes of the Volunteer Center of Barry County, Barry County United Way. The Barry County United Way Volunteer Center responds to community needs by promoting and facilitating volunteerism.*

Domestic Violence

Green Gables Haven Fund – *This fund was established for the purpose of building and maintaining a domestic violence and homelessness shelter. Green Gables Haven will provide a temporary, secure, nurturing environment and support to enable victims of domestic violence in Barry County to make appropriate life-altering changes.*

Education

Barbara Colleen Hooten Memorial Fund – *This fund was established to enhance the educational experiences of elementary age students from Delton and Hastings school systems, occasionally providing college scholarships, and scholarships for Barry County YMCA experiences.*

Barry Intermediate School District Fund – *This fund supports the charitable programs and projects of the Barry Intermediate School District. The purpose of the Barry Intermediate School District is to promote and provide quality educational opportunities for all students, based on best knowledge, through communication, collaboration and coordination of services.*

Carl and Loretta Schoessel Scholarship – HEEF – *This is an annual scholarship given to one male and one female graduating senior from Hastings High School. This scholarship requires each recipient to demonstrate good citizenship and leadership skills within the community as well as the classroom. The scholarship recipient is determined by the Hastings High School faculty and staff, and then approved by HEEF board of directors and approved by BCF.*

Delton Area Education Fund – *The purpose of this fund is to support the educational activities of the students and teachers of the Delton Kellogg Area School District. It is comprised of the Darling Memorial Scholarship, Niebauer Memorial Scholarship, and the Employee Scholarship.*

Dr. Pryor and Friends for Education Fund – This donor advised fund supports the educational opportunities of young working people in Barry County.

Ethel Denton Gross Memorial Scholarship – Ethel’s daughters established this fund to honor their mother’s devotion, skill and passion by assisting others in realizing their capacities through the arts. The fund provides a \$500 scholarship to a student attending a Western Michigan University fine arts program.

Frank Conor Memorial Reaching for the Future Scholarship - This scholarship will be awarded to a Delton Kellogg Alternative High School graduating senior who plans to pursue a career path requiring college or a vocational/technical course of study or equipment/tools required to complete such training.

George and Doris Leonard Scholarship Fund – This fund is used to support the George and Doris Leonard Scholarship and/or related educational purposes for students of Delton Area Schools.

GFWC Hastings Women’s Club “Jumpstart Your Future” Scholarship Fund – This scholarship program was established for the purpose of awarding a scholarship to a needy and deserving female student graduating from Hastings High School, who is pursuing further education at an accredited vocational/technical school, community college, or university.

HEEF – C. Arthur Schoessel Memorial Fund – This fund supports the Hastings Education Enrichment Foundation.

HEEF - Howard and Leona Van Delic Fund – This fund pays two scholarships of \$400 each to be awarded to seniors graduating from Hastings High School. One scholarship is for a student pursuing a degree in education and the other for a business major.

HEEF Helen Mott Fund – This fund awards two scholarships of \$500 each to seniors graduating from Hastings High School. The recipients of these scholarships are determined by Hastings High School faculty and then approved by HEEF board of directors and BCF.

Hofmeister Memorial Scholarship – This scholarship assists with tuition for a music camp each year. The recipient is to be selected by the music faculty of the Delton Kellogg Schools.

Hastings Education Enrichment Foundation Fund – This fund is used exclusively to supplement and enrich the education programs of the Hastings Area School System

and/or its members, as determined from time to time by an advisory committee and approved by the Foundation.

HEEF – Gladys P. Cairns Memorial Fund – *This fund awards three scholarships per year of \$500 each, for four consecutive years to seniors graduating from Hastings High School with at least B- grade point averages throughout high school. The recipients must also present good moral character, financial need and be pursuing four-year degrees.*

HEEF – Hastings Area Rotary Scholarship Fund – *This fund awards one scholarship of \$500 per year for four years consecutively to a senior graduating from Hastings High School. If possible, the scholarship will be awarded to the son or daughter of a Rotarian.*

HEEF – Paul E. and Rosellen E. Siegel Memorial Fund – *This fund awards two scholarships of \$500 each year to needy and deserving Hastings High School seniors who might not otherwise be able to attend college. Special consideration is given to recipients who plan to attend the University of Michigan and Western Michigan University. The scholarships may be for four years and also may continue as support for graduate school, although the amount is subject to review.*

HEEF – Robert Casey Memorial Fund – *This fund supports an annual scholarship for a Hastings area graduating senior. Scholarships are given to students who show interest in the field of education. The recipient is determined by Hastings High School faculty and then is approved by the HEEF board of directors and BCF.*

Jane E. Williston Memorial Scholarship Fund – *This fund shall support of Jane E. Williston Memorial Scholarship for Barry County Residents pursuing a degree as a Registered Nurse.*

JK Simpson Scholarship Fund – *This fund provides scholarships to graduates of the Thornapple Kellogg School District who seek educational opportunities beyond high school at Western Michigan University in the area of nursing (medical sciences will be accepted only if no nursing students apply).*

John F. and Gladys M. Chamberlain Scholarship – *This annual scholarship is given to a student pursuing a degree in math, education, music or history. It is not limited to a graduating senior, but the recipient must be an alumnus of the Delton Kellogg School System.*

Kensinger and Alice Jones Write Away Scholarship – *The “Write Away” competition is for high school students in Barry County interested in careers as writers.*

Cash awards are made for the best short stories, poems and articles submitted through their local English departments and evaluated by an independent panel of judges.

Lindsay Hutt Memorial Scholarship – *This scholarship supports the memory of Lindsay Hutt.*

Mabel H. Foote Scholarship Fund – *This fund is to be used for two annual scholarships and/or related educational purposes. One scholarship will be for a male senior graduating from Hastings High School pursuing a 2- to 4-year degree in agricultural sciences. The other scholarship is for a female graduate of Hastings High School pursuing a 2- to 4-year degree in medical sciences. The scholarship will follow the students through the degree completion.*

Mom’s Scholarship in Memory of Virginia Hoover Harrison Root – *This fund gives a minimum \$500 renewable scholarship to a mom supporting her family by pursuing a vocational/technical or college degree to help herself and her family.*

Robertson Family Scholarship – *This fund provides a scholarship for an alumnus of Thornapple Kellogg Schools.*

Ruth Tangerstrom Memorial Scholarship – *This fund provides a scholarship to support an elementary education degree for a student who needs financial help, has an average grade point and has demonstrated and interest in extra-curricular activities.*

TAEF – Middleville Women’s Club Scholarship Fund – *This fund gives \$400 scholarships varying in amount and availability. The scholarship is for Middleville graduates pursuing 2- to 4-year degrees, every other year, unless otherwise determined by the advisory committee.*

TAEF- Millicent Knox Teacher Scholarship Fund – *This scholarship varies in amount and availability as deemed annually by the board. The scholarship is for a student pursuing a degree in the education field.*

TAEF- Jessica Coe Memorial Fund - *This scholarship varies in amount and availability as deemed annually by the board and surviving family members.*

TAEF- Rodney Schad Memorial Scholarship for Industrial Arts – *This scholarship varies in amount and availability as deemed annually by the board of directors. It is awarded to a Thornapple Kellogg graduating senior who intends to pursue a degree in industrial arts.*

Thomas R. Hamilton Memorial Scholarship – *This scholarship is awarded to a Thornapple Kellogg graduating senior who excels in the classroom and on the Thornapple Kellogg High School tennis team.*

Willard and Jessie Pierce Memorial Scholarship Fund – *This fund supports educational opportunities for young people residing in Barry County.*

Williams Memorial Scholarship – *This scholarship is to be determined by the Delton Kellogg Scholarship Committee.*

Homelessness

Habitat For Humanity Barry County – *This fund is used for the support of the charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes of Habitat for Humanity Barry County. Habitat for Humanity's mission is to build decent affordable houses in partnership with God's children in need.*

Homelessness Prevention Fund – *This fund is for the support of preventing homelessness in Barry County through homelessness prevention activities and/or the expansion of existing prevention services.*

Land Conservation and Historic Preservation

Barry County Conservation District Fund – *This fund is used for the support of the charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes of the Barry Conservation District. The mission of the Barry County Conservation district is to promote responsible natural resource and land-use management for present and future generations.*

Barry County Conservancy Fund – *This fund is used to promote the establishment of land conservancy and conservation as determined from time to time by an advisory committee and approved by the Foundation.*

Barry County Farmland Preservation Fund – *This fund is used to support the preservation of farmland in the Barry County area.*

Barry County Natural Resource Action Team Kellogg Grant Fund – *This fund is to be used solely for the purpose of increasing awareness, interest, and ownership of natural resource issues among Barry County community members and leaders by providing an educational series.*

Catherine Peck Roberts Charlton Park Fund – *This fund supports the enhancement of historical preservation, programs and activities in their broadest scope, including, but not limited to, acquisitions, renovations and coordination of staff, committees and management of Charlton Park, located in Barry County.*

Donor Advised #2 Fund – *This fund is used to match dollars deposited in the Barry County Conservancy Fund by 100%. The fund's donors wish to remain anonymous.*

S. C. Blood Family Fund – This fund is used in the Barry County rural agricultural field for activities, projects, or programs that promote and continue the agricultural and pioneer heritage of the area. Priority is given, but not limited to, Carlton, Woodland Castleton and Irving townships.

Library

Anonymous Donor #3 Fund for District Library – This fund is used to support the activities for the creation of a district library or Hastings Area Library.

Friends of the Hastings Public Library Fund – This fund is used to support the charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes of the Hastings Public Library and its affiliated agencies.

Hastings Public Library Capital Campaign Building Fund – This fund is used to support the building of a new public library facility in Hastings.

Hastings Public Library Special Project Fund – This fund is for the benefit of the Hastings Public Library capital campaign.

Paul & Rosellen Siegel Fund for the Hastings Public Library -This fund is created to support the Hastings Public Library through the estate of Paul and Rosellen Siegel.

Seniors

Barry County Seniors/ Disabled Citizens Fund – This fund is used to assist aged and/or disabled residents of Barry County who are at risk of losing the ability to live in their own homes because they are unable to pay for the necessary modifications and repairs. This fund also allows assistance for those who cannot afford transportation.
