“Nearly a third of all Barry County residents will be over 60 in just six years,” explains Commission on Aging (COA) Director Courtney Ziny, kicking off a capital campaign to expand services with a new home. The new COA will be ideally located near the new Harvest Pointe facility of Thornapple Manor. The new building will offer congregate dining, Meals on Wheels programming, adult day services, and affordable home care assistance for Barry County seniors.
